

Summer Leader

Hours:

- 35-40 hours per week
- These hours are variable according to program schedule, may include evenings
- 8-10 week contract beginning June 16, 2025.

Qualifications:

- Must be 15-30 years of age
- Able to commit for entirety of the summer contract (8-10 weeks beginning in June)
- Have experience and enjoy working with groups of children in a recreational program
- Have previous leadership training and experience with behavior management
- Excellent problem-solving skills and ability to work as part of a team
- First Aid Certification and High Five Principles of Healthy Childhood Development training are mandatory
- Quest 2 Training is considered an asset
- Previous experience with program planning and/or community outreach
- Access to transportation and/or Ability to travel in the Langs, Grow, or North Dumfries Communities

Responsibilities:

- Assist with design, implementation, and supervision of summer playground programs in adherence to the Principles of Healthy Child Development guidelines.
- Complete various administrative duties such as program event plans, program reports, records of time spent and contacts made.
- Conduct outreach to the youth and teen community and when appropriate, provide needed information, access resources and appropriate follow up
- Implement safety standards and norms related to use of equipment within the program
- Ensure and assist participants in conducting clean up after the completion of programs
- Assist in the leadership of other summer programs being offered by the organization as required.
